

Icebreaker Activities

Use these activities when meeting your student for the first time. Instead of jumping into schoolwork right away, take some time to break the ice. These activities will allow you to learn a little bit about your student and get comfortable with one another.

Drawing

Supplies:

- Paper or whiteboard
- Pencils, pens or crayons

Directions:

1. Ask the student if they like to draw
2. If so, invite them to draw a picture
3. Ask them to describe or tell you about what they are drawing

Variation:

- Depending on skill level, invite your student to write a caption or short story that describes their drawing.
- If your student is very young, have them dictate a caption or story for you to write down.
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
