Talk on a Chosen Topic

Directions:

- 1. Ask your student a question about a mutually interesting topic. This might be a book, a movie, an animal, a certain kind of food, a hobby, a sport, or anything in which you are both interested.
- 2. The student answers the questions you pose and then asks you a question on the same topic in return.
- 3. Answer your student's question and then ask them something else. As you take turns, model inferential or thoughtful questions as opposed to literal, less substantive questions. For example: What part of the character was most like you? Versus What was the character's name?
